Need some inspiration?

If you need some inspiration for your photo here are some ideas:

- Capture some contrasts: between 'old' and 'new', 'big' and 'small', 'natural' and 'artificial'
- A close up on a local landmark, or a familiar item seen from an unusual angle
- Depict what happens at a particular time of day – dawn, lunchtime, late at night
- What do you enjoy about South Norwood? Try to capture it in a photo!
- Use light and shadow, the weather, movement, to add interest to your image

The only criteria for the competition is that your image fits the overall theme 'My South Norwood'
